To the inhabitants of the town of Hinsdale in the County of Cheshire in the state of New Hampshire qualified to vote in school district affairs:

You are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Hinsdale High School Gymnasium on Saturday, March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at 9:00AM in the morning to act upon the following subjects:

**Article 2:**

To see if the Hinsdale School District will vote to raise and appropriate the budget committee's recommended amount of \$11,751,613 for the support of schools, for the payment of salaries for the school district officials and agents, and for the payment for the statutory obligations of the district. This article does not include appropriations contained in special or individual articles addressed separately. The school board recommends this appropriation by a 5-0 vote. The budget committee recommends this appropriation by a 7-0 vote. (Majority vote required)




To see if the Hinsdale School District will vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Hinsdale School Board and the Hinsdale Support Staff Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing level:

Fiscal Year	Estimated Increase
2016	\$25,467
2017	\$25,592
2018	\$26,558

and further to raise and appropriate \$25,467 for the current fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels. The school board recommends this appropriation by a 5-0 vote. The budget recommends this appropriation by a 7-0 vote. (Majority vote required)

**Article 4:**

To see if the Hinsdale School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of "up to" \$50,000 to be added to the School Building Maintenance expendable trust fund previously established. This sum to come from June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1. No amount to be raised from taxation. The school board recommends this appropriation by a 5-0 vote. The budget committee recommends this appropriation by a 7-0 vote. (Majority vote required)
