
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The Hinsdale School Board and the Community Connections Committee invite you to join us on Wednesday April 25 for a Community Forum on the topics of Bullying and School Security.

The Community Forum will depart from the more formal format of the monthly school board meetings and will offer an opportunity for a more in depth discussion of these important topics.

BULLYING

The discussion about bullying will be led by Superintendent Wayne Woolridge and members of the Administration. There appears to be some mis-information out in the community regarding the topic of bullying. It is our hope that this forum will help address this mis-information and give parents the tools to help us address the issue of bullying.

Included in this presentation will be information on the Social Emotional Learning curriculum that has been implemented throughout the district.
