Remote Learning with Internet Access

- Parents provide a learning environment at home
- Students log in on Office 365 for each class on time and participate for the class period, students' faces must remain visibly present for the class period via the camera. Attendance will be taken. They do not need to log in to study hall.
- If a student is not in attendance, the school must receive a parent/doctor note. Please contact hmhsattendance@hnhsd.org. After two attempts to reach parents regarding unexcused absences, the SRO will become involved.
- Required Assessments will be scheduled, such as remote exams and summative assessments for semester 1.
- Assigned work will be graded by teachers based on their criteria, and the late work policy will be in effect.
- Pick-up of Materials: Books, Laptops and Chargers will be available for pick-up between 8 AM and 2 PM, Dec. 22 and week of Jan. 4.
- Teachers will have the discretion to have video class time broken into discrete sections: for example, students many log in at the beginning of class, work independently, and then log in again at the end of the class for closing activities. This model may be used to reduce screen time, particularly in the middle school blocks of English and math.
- If a teacher is absent, the student will receive an email from them, with directions on work for the day. Substitute teachers will not provide videoconferencing.
- Meals can be ordered through our front office, at 336-5984 and daily pick-up here will be offered by the cafeteria entrance on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.
- Social and emotional needs: if your child is having any issues, please contact our counselors. We can provide support as needed

Remote Learning without Internet Access

- Parents provide a learning environment at home
- Assignments and learning resources will be provided on a flash drive, which will need to be picked up and exchanged on a weekly schedule.
- Parent or student will need to call the school daily to check in and for attendance purposes. Please contact hmhsattendance@hnhsd.org. If you are unable to attend to school work for a day, the school requires a note from parent with the reason, per attendance policy. If no contact is maintained, the school will attempt to reach out, and the SRO may become involved.
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
