Subject	Description
Academic Recovery	Additional support to address academic gaps.
Athletics- Co- Curricular	Athletics, club, and co-curricular gatherings will resume as normal. Masks will be required for all indoor activities.
Attendance	Continued monitoring and reporting
Communication	Monitor guidance of local, state, and national guidance. Make decisions based on the most updated guidance consistent with the needs of the school community.
Counseling Services	Continued implementation of embedded programming and supports for all students.
Curriculum	Continued use of the district-adopted curriculum.
ELO/Community Service	Continued implementation of activities, following District policy.
Field Trips	Resume District policies
Instructional Model	In-person, onsite, five days per week.
Nursing Services	Continued implementation of embedded programming and supports for all students.
Outdoor Building Space	Continued support of outdoor learning spaces as best practice.
Remote Learning	There will be NO remote learning option.
Section 504/Medical Care Plans	Continued implementation of plans.
Social-Emotional Supports	Continued implementation of embedded programming and supports for all students.
Special Education Services	Continued implementation of individualized education plans (IEPs).

Safety Operations	
Subject	Description
Air Ventilation	Open windows in the classroom, when possible, to circulate air. Filtration systems will be used when windows cannot be opened.
Arrival and Dismissal	Follow building-level protocols
Building Sanitization	Daily Cleaning of classrooms and high-touch, shared surfaces. The classroom will be sanitized daily.
Cafeteria Use (Breakfast, Lunch or Snacks)	Follow building-level protocols
Distancing	Staff and Students are encouraged to maintain physical distancing whenever possible
Face Coverings	Mandatory following CDC Guidance Prevention in K-12 schools. Masks will be worn indoors by ALL individuals (age two and older). Masks will not be required in an outside environment.
Hand Hygiene	Continue best practices for prevention
Playgrounds	Open for use
Screening/ Arrival Departures	No formal screening process before entry.

<p>Stay-At-Home</p>	<p>Stay home when ill and follow reporting protocols if you suspect COVID please follow the procedures below.</p> <p>Home Screening Procedure Before leaving home, students and staff will complete the following steps: Temperatures need to be taken. If the temperature is 100.0°F or higher, students and staff need to stay home. The following questions need to be answered: Are you experiencing any of the following symptoms? ■ Fever and chills ■ Cough ■ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing ■ Fatigue ■ Muscle or body aches ■ Headaches ■ New loss of taste or smell ■ Sore throat, congestion, or runny nose ■ Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea</p> <p>Have you had close contact with someone who is suspected or confirmed to have had COVID-19 in the past 10 days? Have you, during the previous 10 days, traveled internationally or by cruise ship? Before leaving home, every student and staff member should wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.</p> <p>If the answer is YES to any of the above questions, students need to stay home and parents/guardians need to contact the school nurse to report their child’s symptoms, close contact, or travel. Staff need to stay home and report their symptoms, close contact, or travel through Websense, the District’s absence management system.</p> <p>Please contact the school nurses during normal business hours if you need to report close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID or email HES at hesattendance@hnhsd.org or HMHS at hmhsattendance@hnhsd.org</p>
<p>Transportation</p>	<p>Face masks are required when riding the bus. When possible, roof hatches, and windows will be partially opened on the bus to circulate air.</p>
<p>Visitors</p>	<p>Appointments will be required. Visitors will be properly vetted and approved by a district or building administrator and/or department director. Masks will be required when in the buildings.</p>
