

Supplemental Education Services Information 2010-2011

In 2009-2010

A maximum of fourteen students could receive SES tutoring or other academic enrichment services during the 2009-2010 school year, with an initial per pupil cap of \$4,655.30 set by the state. The amount of the pupil cap was larger than in previous years because of additional federal funds available for this program under the *American Recovery and Reinvestment Act* of 2009. Enrollment letters and SES selection forms were sent to eligible families on 9/25/2009, 12/04/2009 and 1/15/2010. The New Hampshire list of providers was included in the mailings and also was available on the school website. Ten students received SES academic tutoring during 2009-2010. *Alpha Academic Services* and *Club Z* provided tutoring in math and reading at Hinsdale Elementary School after the regular school day.

In 2010-2011

A maximum of fourteen students could receive SES tutoring or other academic enrichment services during the 2010-2011 school year. A per pupil cap of \$3,123.77 was set by the state. Enrollment letters and provider selection forms were sent to eligible families on 9/20/2010, 11/20/2010 and 1/20/2011. The NH SES Provider List was included in the mailings and was available on the school website. Ten Hinsdale Elementary students received SES tutoring during 2010-2011, which took place twice a week at the school or at home after the regular school day.

2011-2012

A maximum of fifteen students can receive after school SES tutoring during the 2011-2012 school year. The total number of available student contracts will be shared with students at Hinsdale Middle School, which also is eligible for the program this year. The state has set a per pupil cap of \$3,006.97. Selection forms and information about companies on the New Hampshire provider list will be sent by mail to eligible families. The complete state provider list also is available on the school website, below. The initial enrollment period is beginning November 9, 2011 and will last until December 18, 2011. Two enrollment periods, at separate points in the school year, will be provided until the maximum number of students is reached.
