Two scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 each are to be awarded as follows:

First Scholarship: The **Robert Woodman Scholarship** will be given in memory of Robert Woodman, a Granite State Designers and Installers Association pioneer. The student must be attending school for civil or environmental engineering or environmental science and be a senior in High School. This scholarship will be given to a student that can demonstrate financial hardship, leadership, and community involvement.

Second Scholarship: The **Philip Beland College Scholarship** will be given in memory of Philip Beland, another founding father and long-time supporter of the association. This scholarship will be given to any student that is currently enrolled in college for civil or environmental engineering or environmental science. This scholarship will be given to a student that can demonstrate financial hardship, leadership, and community involvement.

General Requirements and Information:

Completed Application, Academic Resume and Copy of High School Transcript

Essay: Applicants for either scholarship are asked to submit an essay of no more than 500 words which will tell our selection committee about the applicant's educational goals and anticipated career interests. Some indication of inspiration or motivation of why they are choosing their planned field of study is preferred.

Letters of Reference: Two (2) letters of reference are to be submitted with your application. References may include teachers, counselors, members of clergy, employers, volunteer coordinators or other adults from the community other than immediate family members.

Scholarships will be given to the college/institution directly or to the student at the end of the first semester.

The applicant must be a US citizen and live in New Hampshire.
