

National and State Elks' Scholarships; Awards; and Grants Available

There are 4 types of "scholarships" available to students who are already or are planning to attend schools in the USA.

***First** is the **MOST VALUABLE STUDENT** Scholarship. This is open to any graduating senior, U.S. citizen, in the country. Applications must be completed online only, and will be available **August 5** at enf.elks.org/MVS. The deadline for this scholarship is **November 15, 2020**.

***Second** are the **ENF LEGACY AWARDS**. These are available to children or grandchildren only of members of the Elks in good standing. The applications must be completed online, and will be available **September 1** at enf.elks.org/Leg. The deadline is **February 5, 2021**.

***Third** are the **EMERGENCY EDUCATIONAL GRANTS**. These are grants for children of deceased or totally disabled Elks. Applications are available from **May 1** through **November 2** of the academic year for which the assistance is needed. The site is scholarships@elks.org

***Fourth** are the **ROGER SHERIDAN SCHOLARSHIPS** awarded to a girl and a boy who plan to major in physical education or related field. This scholarship is sponsored through the Vermont Elks Association and applications are due **February 1, 2021** and distributed by request.
