### Community:

Hinsdale Middle/High School is located in the southwestern corner of New Hampshire in Cheshire County. Hinsdale has a population of approximately 4,000 people. It has a primary focus of light industry and farming enterprises. Hinsdale is home to part of Pisgah State Park in the northeast and part of the Wantastiquet Mountain State Forest in the Northwest. Both the Ashuelot River and the Connecticut River run through Hinsdale.

### School:

Hinsdale Middle/High School is a Middle-Senior School with approximately 257 students enrolled in grades 6-12. There are 40 full and part time faculty members with an average class size of 14 students. The class of 2020 had 32 seniors graduate with 58% going on to postsecondary education, 37% entering the workforce and another 5% going into the Military. Ability grouping occurs with college prep/advance classes and general classes being offered in the core classes.

Hinsdale High School is accredited by the New Hampshire Department of Education and The New England Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools.
