- Be a High School senior
- Complete the scholarship application form
- Submit one (1) resume with one (1) letter of recommendation and a 250-1500 word essay describing why you want to study social work/psychiatry/psychology/behavioral science *or* your involvement with mental health and/or suicide prevention and its importance to you
- Have completed at least 20 hours of community service during high school
