Board Business

M. Darcy stated he hoped this will be the first of what would be quarterly meetings between the two boards. The focus of this meeting would be a discussion of what the two boards could accomplish and setting a meeting on September 16, 2019 at 6:00 pm at the SAU to start preliminary work on the 2020-2021 budget.

K. Hemlow explained a joint project that she would like to work on, it would be a Welcome Wagon project that would concentrate on people that have just had children born and also people that have just moved into the area. Some of the items that would be included would be a directory to help people find services, information on items such as dog licenses, car registrations etc. It would be great if grants could be found to fund items of this. B. Rideout asked about funding and if the school district had heard anything. W. Woolridge explained what was happening in the legislature to date. It looks like Hinsdale would receive approximately one million more in adequacy over the next two years. The district would also be seeing an increase in catastrophic aid. We should know more by June 28.
