## HASP's Frequently Asked Questions about dismissal, absences and cost

### **My child will not be attending HASP today, what should I do?**

If your child will NOT be attending HASP on a day they are scheduled, please do one of the following:

\*Send an email to [hesattendance@hnhsd.org](mailto:hesattendance@hnhsd.org) or [momalley@hnhsd.org](mailto:momalley@hnhsd.org) indicating that your child will not attend that day or you may send in a note that morning. Please do NOT email your child's teacher as they do not always have time to check emails prior to dismissal. The office will let the classroom teacher and HASP staff know of this change.

\* Call the main office. If you must call the office to indicate your child will be absent from HASP, please do so by 2:45pm. This will provide sufficient time for the office to notify your child's teacher and HASP.

All HASP dismissals will take place at the cafeteria door. We ask that you let your child remain until at least 5:30pm to receive the full benefit of the program. In the event that you must pick up your child at regular dismissal (3:20pm) and you have not made arrangements with the office, your child will be dismissed after walkers/car riders and bus dismissals have been completed. This will ensure that our dismissals are completed in a safe, efficient manner.

### **Who may pick my child up from HASP?**

Students will be required to be signed out by the adult picking up each day. The registration form, attached, provides a few spaces to indicate who will be allowed to take your child from HASP. **No child** will be released from the program unless the person picking up is indicated on the registration form. If someone different is picking up your child on any given day, please email me ([momalley@hnhsd.org](mailto:momalley@hnhsd.org)) or send in a note to provide this information. Also, if your child is registered to attend HASP but will **not** be attending on a certain day, please email a message to the above address or call the school (603-336-5332) before 2:45pm to let us know they will **not** be attending and how they will go home. **Please note: ID will be required for anyone arriving to pick up a child who is not recognizable to a HASP staff member.**

### **What types of activities are available for my child?**

HASP provides a variety of academic and enrichment opportunities throughout each day. Our academic activities are based on grade-level needs (determined by NHSAS results) while our enrichment opportunities change quarterly and are based on student voice and choice.

### **What does it cost to attend HASP?**

The Hinsdale School District has been awarded the 21st Century Community Learning Center Grant. This grant currently provides funding for HASP. A fee structure has been created in the event that there is a disruption in funding. All students identified through our Target Procedure and Policy as well as scholarship applicants will attend program at NO cost. Also, per grant guidelines, HASP will not turn away students based on a family's inability to pay. Currently, there is no cost to attend program.

## HASP MORNING PROGRAM

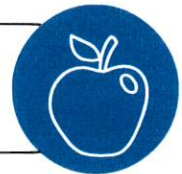
