Dear Parents/Guardians,

The mid-point of the school year is just around the corner! Students and teachers are preparing for the end of Semester 1 assessments. We will be following an exam schedule for the middle and high school, with some days having early dismissals. There are several changes in our calendar that you need to be aware of, which are listed below.

- Monday, January 16: no school in observance of Martin Luther King
- Friday, January 20: early release at HMHS at 11:45 AM, for district wide professional development
- Monday, January 23: early release at HMHS at 1:00, exam day
- **Tuesday, January 24**: early release at HMHS at 1:00, exam day
- Wednesday, January 25: early release at HMHS at 1:00, exam day

The exams are comprehensive, assessing what students have learned during the first semester, with no more than two exams per day. A break is scheduled between exams, and lunch is provided. Friday, January 27, the last day of the second quarter, is reserved for exams in the event of a snow day during testing, or for make-ups due to individual student absences.

**Please review the schedule on the back of this sheet.** Students in grade 6 will not be taking exams. These students will be completing mid-year Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) testing, which students in grades 7 and 8 will do the following weeks. MAP testing helps guide academic intervention and enrichment before students participate in end-of-year Smart Balanced Assessments or SBAC testing.
