Hinsdale High School has an opportunity to have all seniors take the SAT's free of charge! The SAT is the standardized test that most colleges ask our students to take as part of the college admission process. Due to seniors not being about to take it in the spring of their Junior year it will now take place this fall.

Students will take this test on October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 during the school day. All students must be on site to begin testing by 7:50 AM. Our school has also opted to have every student take the essay portion of the test with the school covering the additional cost. This translates to approximately a \$65 savings to families. This opportunity also allows students to take the test in a familiar setting without needing to take time out of their weekend activities to participate. This test will take all morning. Please make arrangements for your student to be in school and on time that day to accommodate this timing.

For remote students, it is mandatory that you come into school on this day and participate in the SAT. This test is required by the state of NH for all students in grade 12 this year.

This is a full SAT test that can be submitted to colleges of a student's choosing. Students receive four free score reports to be sent to these colleges. Students can choose any colleges they wish, and it does not matter if they end up applying there or not. Students have up to two weeks following the test to decide what colleges to send the scores to. After that time, the student will need to pay for each report they want sent.

Further, I want to let you know about the Free Application for Federal Student Aid or FAFSA Night for Parents. This will take place on October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 6:30pm via Zoom. Students will participate in a Zoom meeting as well earlier in the day at 2:45pm. This webinar is presented to you in collaboration with NH Higher Education Assistance Foundation to go over the FAFSA process and to hopefully answer any questions you may have. There will be more information to come.
