

New Hampshire PTA SCHOLARSHIP

New Hampshire State PTA awards a Graduating High School Senior Scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 to acknowledge the achievements of high school seniors for volunteer service in the school and community.

AVAILABILITY: New Hampshire PTA scholarship funds are available to graduating high school seniors. The NH PTA Scholarship is to be used during fall semester/quarter following high school graduation at an accredited* college or university, community college or trade/technical school.

QUALIFICATIONS: This scholarship recognizes volunteer service in the school and community. Applicant must be 1. a New Hampshire resident; 2. graduating from a high school in New Hampshire and be affiliated with a PTA/PTSA unit in good standing; 3. Have completed 50 hours of volunteer service during their 4 years of high school.

Application and Due Date:

1. The application and accompanying reference forms may be obtained from: • the New Hampshire PTA office; • the website at nhpta1.org. The final application packet must include:

1. a completed application form;
2. a one page an essay describing a. any PTA/PTSA responsibility you may have; b. how your family's involvement with PTA/PTSA and how that has affected your education and your commitment to community service during high school and into the future.
3. reference forms and letters;
 - a. reference form and letter written specifically for this scholarship application;
 - b. first reference form and letter completed by a community volunteer leader or staff member with whom student applicant has served (may not be related to student);

Note: Each completed reference form and letter should be given to the applicant directly to be submitted with the application.

Submission instructions: 1. Original application, and reference forms with letters must be mailed together in ONE envelope. 2. The application must be received in the New Hampshire PTA office by close of business May 1, if mailed, or by 11:59 PM PDT if emailed. a. Application will not be considered if received after due date or if any of the required materials are missing. b. When May 1 falls on a weekend, applications are due in the New Hampshire PTA office by close of business the following Monday.

Selection: Recipients are selected by members of the NH PTA Scholarship Committee and include educators, doctors and administrators. Winning student will be notified by June 1. A check for the scholarship will be mailed directly to the recipient August 1.
