## **Dorcas & Peter Pombay Scholarship**

Dorcas and Peter believed that many bright students in Hinsdale don't get a chance to attend post-secondary schools because they cannot afford to do so. This scholarship gives a Hinsdale student a chance to financially achieve their dream of attending college.

This scholarship, which began in 2003, will be given each year to a deserving high school graduate of Hinsdale High School, Hinsdale, New Hampshire. Students receiving this scholarship must have demonstrated in their daily lives a willingness to go out of their way to help others as well as the need for financial aid. This scholarship will be disbursed in equal payments each *consecutive* semester. The recipient remains a full-time undergraduate student at a post-secondary school with passing grades. Payments *will not exceed* a time limit of four years and payments *will not exceed* the original amount of the scholarship awarded at graduation. All payments will be disbursed by the New Hampshire Charitable Foundation after proof of semester completion (transcript) and Semester 2 classes are received by them. Any unused portion of this scholarship is forfeited once the recipient is no longer a full-time student in an accredited post-secondary school unless extenuating circumstances prevail, and an appeal is approved by the New Hampshire Charitable Foundation. (ex: medical)
