GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS

A least one scholarship will be award by the Vermont State Association each year. The following general rules must be followed by each applicant.

1. Application must be made on the State Scholarship Application provided by the local Emblem Club.
2. Applications must be accompanied by:
 - A. A copy of applicant's high school transcript received during the four years of high school or a copy of the first college semester transcript if applicant is already a college student.
 - B. Letters of recommendation from two persons (Not immediate family) relative to the character of applicant as well as any other pertinent information. Letters are to be addressed to "Dear Scholarship Committee".
 - C. A photo copy of CEEB/SAT test scores if taken.
3. Completed applications must be submitted to the guidance office by April 10th.
4. Scholarship monies must be used for college tuition, books, etc., or must be returned to the State Association.
5. The decision of the State Scholarship Committee will be final.
6. When an applicant is chosen as a winner of a scholarship by the State Scholarship Committee, the applicant must submit a copy of the letter of acceptance from the college they will attend, before a check will be issued. The check will be written to both the student and the college.
