Eligibility Requirements:

1. Resident of the Town of Hinsdale or Winchester in New Hampshire or the child of a member of the Club.
2. Applicant is to be a high school senior with a plan of study at a 2 or 4 year college or university or technical school.
3. A letter of Acceptance from the college or university or technical school is required.
4. Applicant will describe their experience(s) in community service.
5. Applicant will describe their experience(s) in paid employment if applicable.
6. Applicant will describe in a few paragraphs the answer to one of the following questions:
 - a. If you had the ability to change your town in a positive way, what specific changes would you make?
 - b. Pick an experience from your own life and explain how it has influenced your view of what community means?
